A LEGACY OF SERVICE

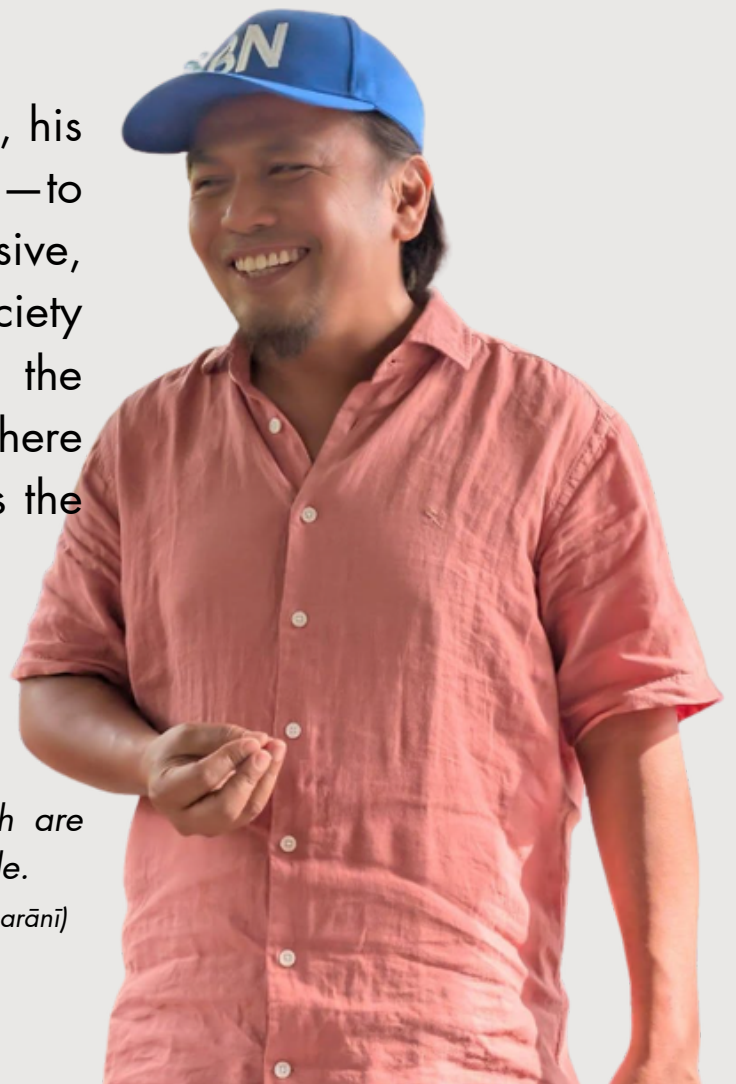
T rue leadership is not measured by titles held or achievements attained, but by the lives touched, the opportunities created, and the positive impact left behind.
